I Deputy Wager was dispatched to 13988 FM 974 at 13:23 hours for an animal complaint of a possible mutilated livestock carcass of a calf. The call was called in by Madison County Investigator Carly Foster [REDACTED]. I was in route to the location. I called and spoke with Carly Foster at the [REDACTED]. I inquired about the issue. She advised that the calf that was dead may be of interest to her in her on gong investigation of mutilated livestock in her county. I inquired if she wanted me to relay information to her, she advised that she was almost on scene at this time. I advised that I would see her on scene. I arrived on scene and found her [REDACTED] three Madison county/city officers on scene. They were around the calf upon my arrival. They were accessing the calf. They had turned the calf over looking on the side of the calf that was down on the ground. They were looking for bullet wounds on the calf. The area around the calf was beat down from the many people around the calf. I walked over and watch while he was looking for a wound. He did not find a wound. I then turned the calf back over to the side it was on when found. The jaw of the calf had it's hide peeled back from its nose and above its nose on the bridge at an angle down to the bottom of its jaw line. The animals tongue was gone. The animal's jaw bone was exposed as no meat was on the bone of either one on the lower bones. The calf's eye was gone. I did seen some tissue damage around the anus of the calf. I did not see any remains of the skin that was gone from the calf around the location. The owner and the other rancher were thinking someone had killed the calf. They then cut the skin away and then removed the tongue in some sort of ritual or some other reason.

The owner [REDACTED] advised that he had last seen the calf alive the previous day, 04/23/2023, around noon. The owner advised that he found the calf today. I advised him and them that the calf needed to be sent off for testing to Texas A&M for a necropsy to determine the cause of death and the results of the injury to the calf/carcass. I advised them that I did not have the authority to authorize one or that the county was not going to authorize paying for one. The owner advised that he would pay for the necropsy on the calf. Sergeant Fraley had arrived sometime during this time. [REDACTED] loaded the calf into [REDACTED] truck. I gave him my card to give to Texas A&M to send me the results. They also will be sending Carly Foster the results.

I called later and touched base [REDACTED]. He advised that he had dropped the calf off successfully and gave them my card. He advised that he would call if he heard something and I advised that I would advise him the same.
